Subject: **Division Statistics Quiz**

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, issued on September 20, 1990, declaring the month of October as the National Statistics Month (NSM) and in celebration thereof, there will be a Division Statistics Quiz Bee on October 14, 2019 at 9:00 AM at the Dap-ayan Hall-Schools Division Office, Bontoc.
2. The objectives of the quiz bee are to instill awareness and appreciation on the importance and value of statistics among teachers and students and to prepare for possible Regional Statistics Quiz Bee.
3. Participants to the quiz bee include one grade 11 or grade 12 student per senior high school.
4. Coaches are enjoined to prepare 1 easy, 1 average and 1 difficult multiple choice questions encoded on an A4 bond paper. There shall be 4 choices labelled A, B, C and D. The correct answer shall be boxed. Enough spaces between questions should be provided.
5. The Division Math coordinator shall form the quiz bee committee to serve as quiz master, timer and proctors from among the coaches.
6. Questions should be crafted from general information, basic educational statistics and general statistics.
7. Attached is the Mechanics of the Division Statistics Quiz. Coaches are enjoined to read the mechanics of the quiz before preparing the questions for proper guidance.
8. Travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds subject to auditing rules and regulations.
9. For widest dissemination and strict compliance.

Guidelines/ Mechanics of the 2019 Division Statistics Quiz

1. The contestants are grade 11 or grade 12 students (1 per school). Each contestant shall bring his or her school ID bearing his/ her Learner Registration Number (LRN).
2. Cellphones, tablets, or any other electronic communication devices are not allowed during the competition proper.
3. There will be three components in the competition: Easy Round, Average Round and Difficult Round.
4. Each easy question is answerable in 10 seconds and is given 1 point. Each average question is answerable in 20 seconds and is given 2 points. Each difficult question is answerable in 30 seconds and is given 3 points.
5. Questions will include general information, basic educational statistics and general statistics.
6. Before the start, the quiz committee shall collect the questions prepared by the coaches, sort then decide as to how many questions will be drawn and read in order to save questions which shall serve as clinchers.
7. Each contestant will be provided with A, B, C and D cards which will serve as answer cards.
8. Each question will have the following sequence:
 - a. The quiz master will draw a question from the draw lots box then read twice. A timer will start after the quiz master says, "**GO**".
 - b. Each contestant will raise his/ her answer card when the quiz master will say "**Time is UP**" and wait until the scores are properly recorded.
 - c. The quiz master will announce the correct answer for the questions. The assigned proctors will check each contestant's answer card to determine if their answer is correct or wrong.
9. In case of a tie, tie-breaker questions will be given until the tie is broken. Points for the clincher is given in accordance to the level of the question (easy, average or difficult).
10. Decisions of the Quiz Committee shall be final and non-appealable.
